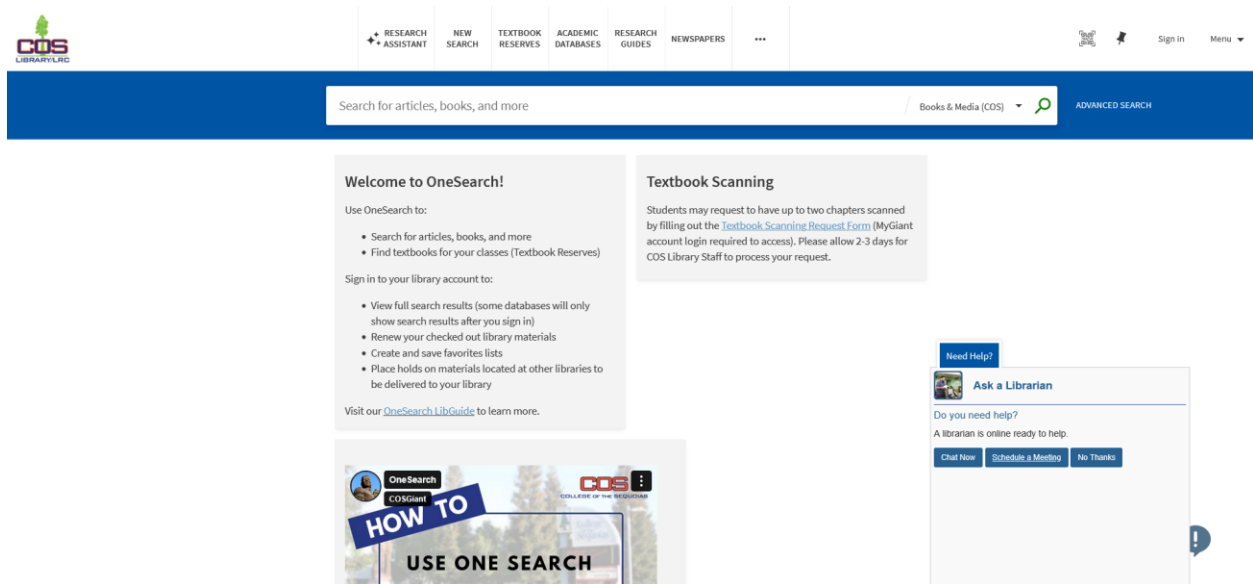
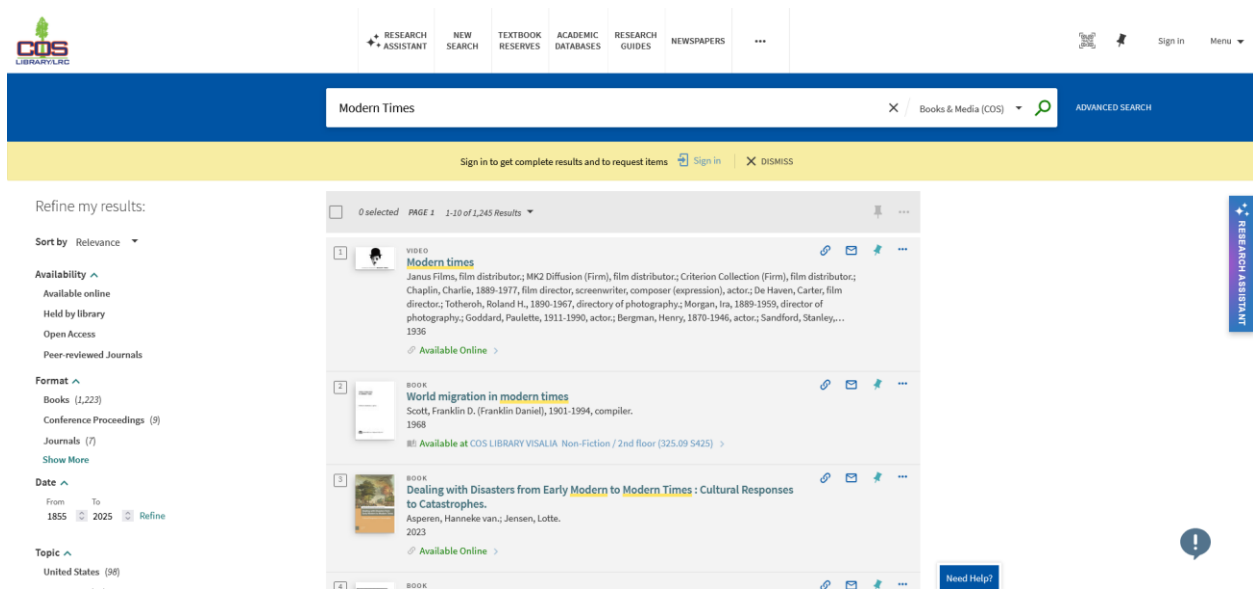


How to Search OneSearch for Streaming Videos

Step 1: Navigate to COS Library Catalog: OneSearch.



Step 2: Have the search set to Books & Media, then type in the title of the video into the search bar.



Step 3: Find the correct record in the list of results. Click on “Available Online.” The full details of the record should appear.
